This Letter of Clarification is issued for the following reasons:

1. To provide a response to vendor questions as follows:

ID #	Vendor Question	City of Houston Response
1.	Bush Intercontinental Airport: What is the height (in feet from ceiling to floor) of the atriums in the ticketing areas of each terminal?	Height ranges from 8' up to 80'
2.	Bush Intercontinental Airport: What is the height (in feet from ceiling to floor) in the terminal (by the gates)?	Height ranges from 8' up to 80'
3.	Bush Intercontinental Airport: If we are using a lift in the atriums of the ticketing area (on the inside), how much weight can the floor hold?	The public areas are usually designed for 100 pounds/sq. ft. uniformly distributed load.
4.	Hobby Airport: What is the height (in feet from ceiling to floor) in the terminal (by the gates)?	30 ft.
