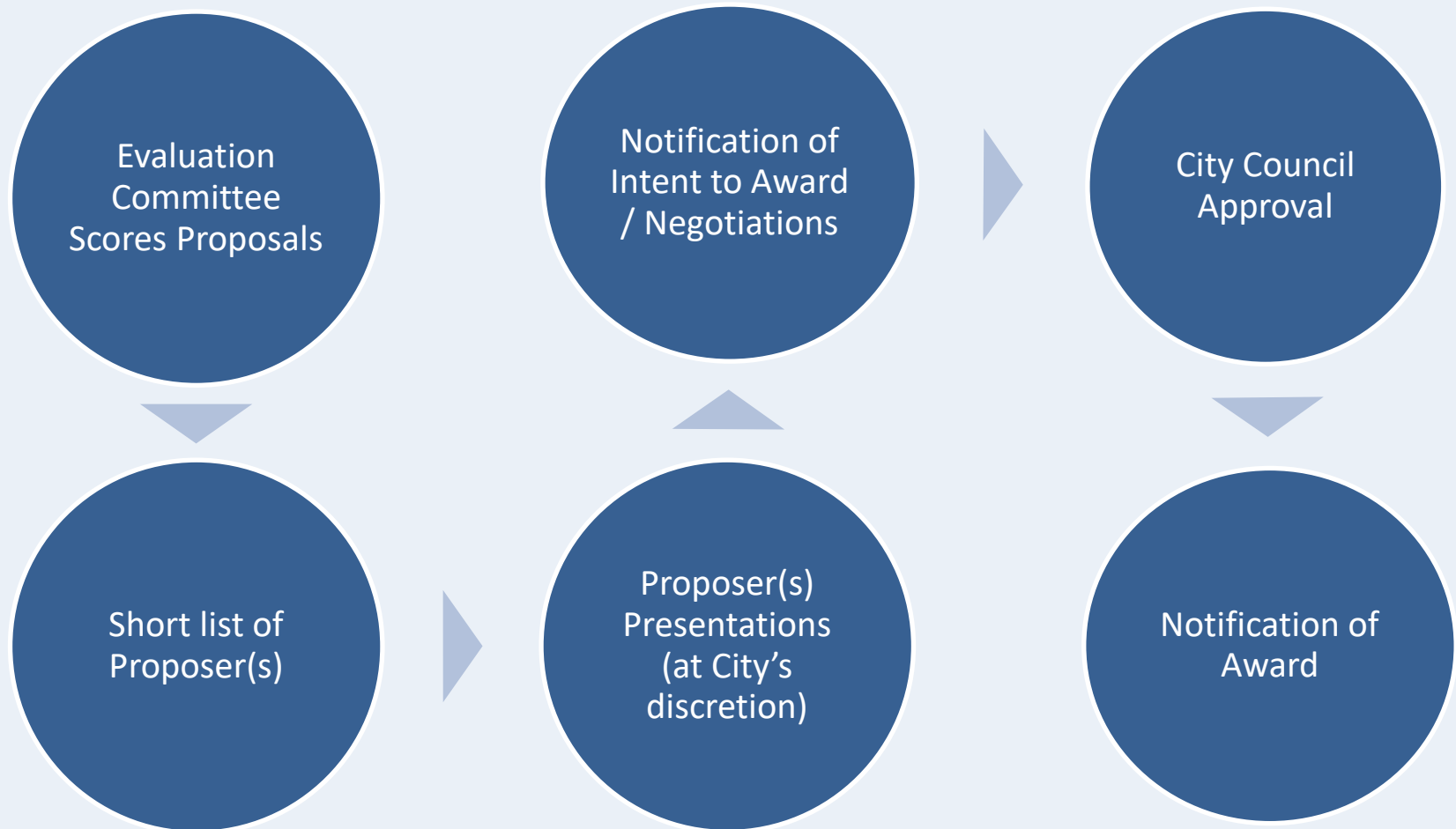
Professional Qualifications and Experience of Proposer's Team
